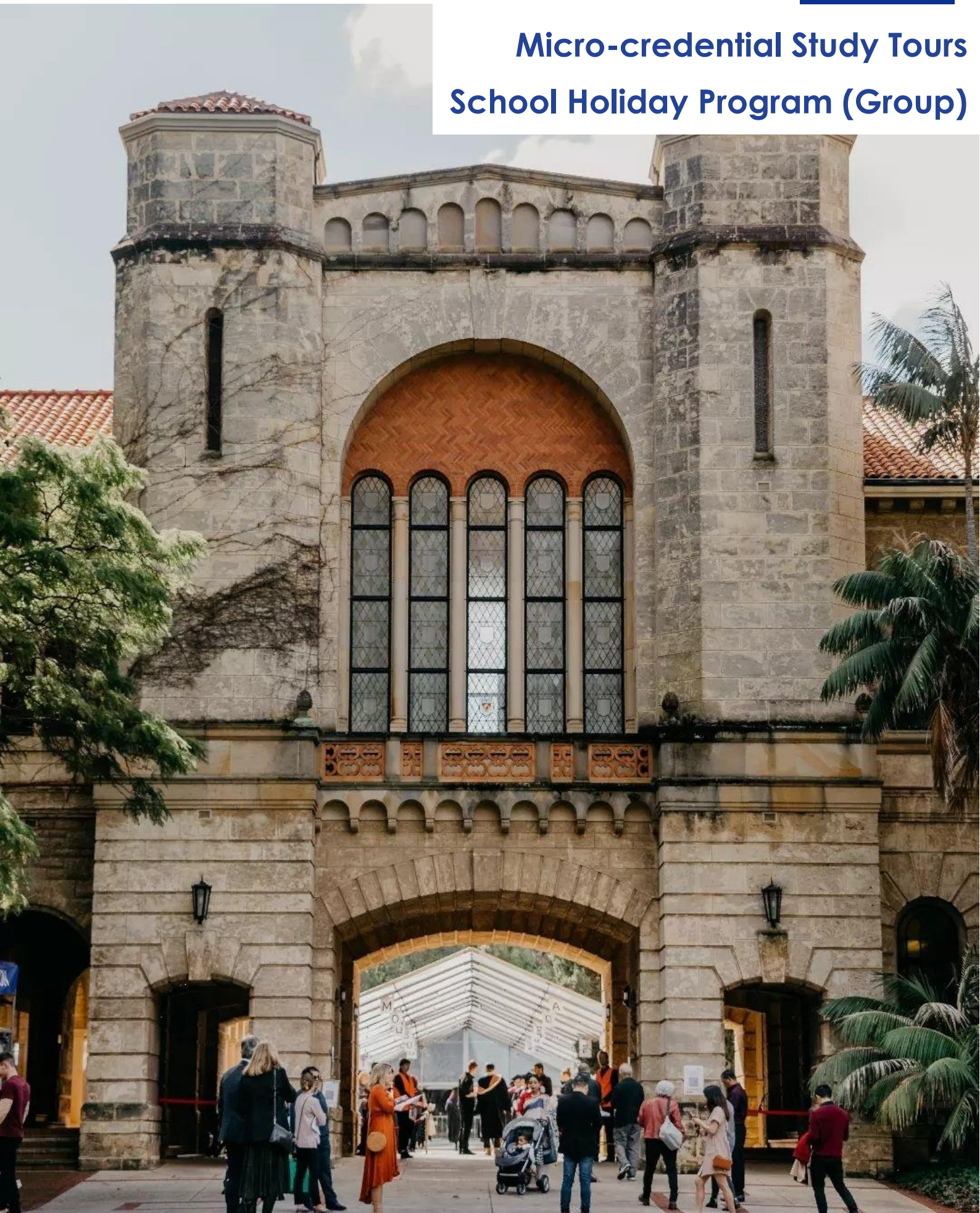

Admission Requirements

- ★ Domestic and International students
- ★ Aged 18 years or above
- ★ Non-current UWA student
- ★ High-level of English language and comprehension skills are required to complete the course, IELTS 5.5 or equivalent is recommended

Important notes:

- ★ All international students must arrange their own travel and medical insurance to attend the course.
- ★ Students will need to accumulate 6 credit points to receive RPL for one elective unit before they commence a degree at UWA.
- ★ Students may choose to complete additional micro-credentials online course to gain additional credits.
- ★ Personal laptop required.

Terms & Conditions (Group)

General

- At least one responsible adult (group leader) must accompany the group with the student under 18.
- Students have made this application having had access to sufficient information regarding the details of the program like course requirements, fees, facilities and services.
- All activities will be delivered but Uni Link reserves the right to change the order in which activities are delivered to suit the timetable and availability. It may be necessary to substitute activities should the weather be inclement. This will be discussed with the group leader if needed.
- Any request to change the arrangement after confirmation is subject to approval and may result in extra costs.
- No midway join-in once the program is started.
- No refund will be arranged if the student decides not to join any class or/and activity during the program.
- A Certificate of Achievement and an academic transcript will only be issued to the student who successfully passed the course.
- Photos or videos taken during the program will be used for marketing purposes.

Information and Privacy

- All information provided to Uni Link should be complete and current. Students understand incomplete information and documentation may result in an unsuccessful application.
- Students authorise Uni Link to book and arrange for the program on their behalf including the disclosure of the information to any person or organisation, for the purposes of successful development and delivery of this program.

Group size

A minimum number of students required to run the program. If the number of students is less than the proposed number, please advise as soon as possible and request another proposal.

Accommodation

- Students agree to abide by the accommodation provider's rules and guidelines or a fine will be charged.
- Shared bathroom is common in university accommodation. Personal hygiene items like toothbrushes, body wash, slippers, hair dryers, etc. will not be provided.
- Same-sex arrangements will apply to shared room accommodation. Single bookings in a twin-share room will attract an additional fee.
- Standard accommodation check-in time is 2pm and check-out time is 10am. Early check-in or late check-out is subject to approval. Additional costs or extra charges on temporary accommodation may be incurred for check-in/check-out times outside of the standard.

Loss & Insurance

- Each student must be insured by travel and medical insurance for the entire duration of the program.
- Uni Link is not responsible for any expenses, losses, injuries, damages, inconvenience, etc., sustained by any person in the program.

Booking and Payment

- No related booking has been made at this point.
- Booking is subject to payment of AUD500 deposit per head upon application and it is non-refundable.
- Full payment must be received at least 8 weeks prior to the start of the program.

- Group payment only (Bank transfer or Telegraphic Transfer). Bank charges or any surcharges will not be covered by Uni Link.

Force majeure

In the event of outside reasonable control and/or not being in a position to prevent the event and affect the delivery of the program, no refund and no responsibility will be taken by Uni Link. Refunds or compensation will be subjected to their own travel insurance.

Below are some examples of the event (including but not limited to):

- Weather and natural disasters;
- War, riot or act of terrorism;
- A government direction or sanctioned lockdown;
- Widespread illness like an epidemic or pandemic.

Amendments

Substitutions are permitted once only and up to 8 weeks prior to the course start day. Additional charges may apply due to the gender split and rooming arrangement.

Cancellations

- All notices of cancellation must be informed by writing (A Withdrawal and Refund Form needs to be completed) and is not effective until received by Uni Link.
- Bank charges or other surcharges will not be covered by Uni Link.
- In case of cancellation, the refund will be arranged based on the following table.
